Other local attractions are also minutes away, including the [National Aquarium](#), [Maryland Science Center](#), a large variety of museums, and historic ships on the harbor. Take a harbor water taxi. Visit the nearby historic [Fells Point](#) community, founded 1726, and known for its spirited nightlife and restaurants.
